

**PARENTS NOTICE
FOR KIDS UNDER AGE 10
FACILITY USAGE POLICY

CHILDREN UNDER AGE 10 MUST BE WITH A PARENT OR ADULT AT ALL TIMES, UNLESS THE CHILD IS ENROLLED IN A YMCA PROGRAM. CHILDREN UNDER AGE 10 CANNOT BE SURPERVISED BY A BROTHER, SISTER OR ANOTHER RELATIVE WHO IS NOT AT LEAST AGE 18.

EXCEPTIONS:

***Children age 9 and under who pass the swim test MUST have a parent, or adult in the YMCA at all times. Those who fail the swim test MUST have a parent, or adult in the pool water at all times.**

***The youth gymnasium is open to ages 9-14, 9 year olds may use the gym but a parent, or adult MUST remain in the YMCA at all times. The youth gym is closed between May-Aug. for day camp use,etc... Check flyer rack for schedule.**

*****When children under age 10 are ready to leave these areas, a parent, or adult must come to the area and leave with the child.**

IF IN A PROGRAM, CHILD MUST BE PICKED UP ONCE THE PROGRAM IS OVER. IF AFTER ONE HOUR OF UNSUCCESSFUL EFFORT TO CONTACT PARENT, GUARDIAN OR RELATIVE, THE YMCA IS LEGALLY OBLIGATED TO CALL SOCIAL SERVICES OR THE HENDERSON CITY POLICE FOR THEM TO TRY AND CONTACT YOU.

THIS IS TO PROTECT YOUR CHILD IN CASE OF AN EMERGENCY AT THE YMCA, OR IF YOUR CHILD WERE TO BECOME ILL OR INJURED. PARENTS NEED TO BE AWARE THAT THE YMCA CANNOT PROPERLY SUPERVISE CHILDREN LEFT AT THE YMCA WITHOUT PARENT SUPERVISION, UNLESS ENROLLED IN A YMCA PROGRAM.

*****CHILDREN AGE 10-13 MAY NOT BE AT THE YMCA WITHOUT A PARENT OR ADULT SUPERVISION FOR LONGER THAN 4 HOURS ON ANY ONE DAY. IF SO, CHILD WILL BE ASKED TO CALL A PARENT OR RELATIVE TO COME PICK THEM UP, BUT THE Y CAN NOT STOP ANY CHILD FROM LEAVING THE Y FACILITY OR PROPERTY IF AGE 10+.**

*****CONTINUOUS VIOLATION OF THE AGE REQUIREMENTS OR TIME RESTRICTION WILL RESULT IN TERMINATED MEMBERSHIP AND/OR LOSE THE USE OF ALL THE YMCA FACILITIES IF NOT A MEMBER.**

UNSUPERVISED DROP OFF POLICY

YOUR CHILD HAS BEEN DROPPED OFF OR BROUGHT TO THE YMCA IN VIOLATION OF OUR FACILITY USAGE POLICY, WHICH STATES THAT NO CHILD LESS THAN 10 YEARS OLD MAY BE AT THE YMCA UNLESS A PARENT, ADULT OR RELATIVE AT LEAST AGE 18 OR OLDER IS WITH THE CHILD AT ALL TIMES, OR THE CHILD IS ENROLLED IN A YMCA PROGRAM DURING THE TIME HE OR SHE IS HERE. UNDER AGE CHILDREN CAN NOT BE SUPERVISED BY A BROTHER SISTER OR A FRIEND WHO IS NOT AT LEAST AGE 18.

IF IN A PROGRAM, CHILD MUST BE PICKED UP ONCE THE PROGRAM IS OVER. IF AFTER ONE HOUR OF UNSUCCESSFUL EFFORT TO CONTACT A PARENT, GUARDIAN OR RELATIVE, THE YMCA IS LEGALLY OBLIGATED TO CALL SOCIAL SERVICES OR THE HENDERSON CITY POLICE FOR THEM TO TRY AND CONTACT YOU.

THIS IS TO PROTECT YOUR CHILD IN CASE OF AN EMERGENCY AT THE YMCA, OR IF YOUR CHILD WERE TO BECOME ILL OR INJURED.

PARENTS NEED TO BE AWARE THAT THE YMCA CANNOT PROPERLY SUPERVISE CHILDREN LEFT AT THE YMCA WITHOUT PARENT SUPERVISION, UNLESS ENROLLED IN A YMCA PROGRAM.

*****CHILDREN AGE 10-13 MAY NOT BE LEFT AT THE YMCA WITHOUT ADULT SUPERVISION FOR LONGER THAN 4 HOURS ON ANY ONE DAY.**

IF SO, CHILD WILL BE ASKED TO CALL A PARENT OR RELATIVE TO COME PICK THEM UP, BUT THE Y CAN NOT STOP ANY CHILD FROM LEAVING THE Y FACILITY OR PROPERTY IF AGE 10+.

****CONTINUOUS VIOLATION OF THE AGE REQUIREMENTS OR TIME RESTRICTION WILL RESULT IN TERMINATED MEMBERSHIP AND/OR LOSE THE USE OF ALL YMCA FACILITIES IF NOT A MEMBER.**
